

Age: Preschoolers (5-6 years old)

Purpose: Language, social and math competences

Material: 2 giant dice, 12 hula hoops, a jar.

Skills: identifying odd and even numbers, associate quantity/number, taking turns, mental calculations, counting.

Time: 30/45min
1- First the teacher lays down 12 hula hoops each one numbered.
2- The class is divided into 2 groups.
3- One student from each team will have the chance to roll the dice and to associate the quantity to the number by tossing a bean bag. Afterwards the student must say if it is an odd or even number.
4- The team with most right answers win.
5- Afterwards the students divided in the same two teams will have to guess the correct result for each sum/subtraction and run to their team color hula hoop.
6- If there is still time, students can play the kaboom game.
7- In this game students sit in a circle, and they take turns to choose a wood medical stick with a sum or subtraction. If the answer is correct, they can keep the stick if not they put it back into the jar. However, if they chose a kaboom stick they must put all their sticks back in the jar. The winner is the first student to collect 5 sticks.
