





Subject: Math game "Dog Race|"

General objectives:

- consolidation of basic qualitative features of geometric figures: triangle, circle, square, rectangle;
- improving the perception and recognition of the shape of geometric figures;
- consolidation of knowledge of numbers, can count elements;
- practising visual analysis and synthesis,
- developing perceptiveness and concentration of attention;
- Comply with the agreements in force in the game;
- participating in games and activities integrating the group:

Working methods:

- active (method of tasks assigned to the child, method of independent experiments, method of exercises);
- verbal (conversation, explanations).

Forms of work: individual, team, collective.

Teaching aids:

• geometric figures (circle, square, triangle, rectangle) cut out of cardboard, boards with numbers 1-10, game board, game pieces (dogs), dice, three sets of cards with tasks.

Course of classes:

1. Greeting Song- Hello!- super Simple Song

The children sing a welcome song together with the teacher.

2. Figures – a game that reminds and consolidates the appearance and names of geometric figures.

Children sit in a circle on the carpet. N. assigns them individual geometrical figures (circle, triangle, square, rectangle). At the agreed sign, giving the name of a given figure, the children with this





figure get up, run around the seated people once and return to their seats. On the slogan: all the figures stand up and rotate around their axis.

3. Consolidation of knowledge of numbers 1-10.

The teacher shows a piece of paper with a number on it, and the children name it.

4. Math game "Dog Race"

Children's participation in the game, learning through play. We divide the children into teams and assign pawns (dogs). The teams take turns rolling the dice and moving around the board. If a player stands on a square with a bowl, he draws a task of the appropriate color. Once the correct answer is given, the game continues. If players make a mistake, they go back to the previous square.

5. Ending – singing the song "Bye Bye Goodbye" in English

The children sing a farewell song together with the teacher.
