Outline of the activity:

- 1. Warm-up.
- 2. Introduction of the artist Vincent Van Gogh.
- 3. Introduction of language of color, Number and shape
- 4. Children identify and repeat.
- 5. Talk about the painting in the room.
- 6. Ask children to identify shapes in the room.
- 7. Explain the bedroom painting and ask children to color the painting in puzzle shape.
- 8. Children have to cut, glue and assemble the puzzle.
